
- The Marlands is BUSIEST on Thursday / Friday / Saturday between 11am and 4pm.

You can get to The Marlands Shopping Centre in the car.

You can park your car in the multi-storey Car park behind ASDA Sat Nav for parking is SO14 7EN The car park has 600 spaces It is open 24 hours a day

You can also Park in the NCP Car Park

Sat Nav for parking is SO15 1QH The car park has 810 spaces It is open 24 hours a day


